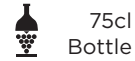

1. ROOS ESTATE SAUVIGNON BLANC (South Africa) 1 16.95

Produced out of the Western Cape region, this is a refreshing, great value for money Sauvignon with delicate gooseberry and grapefruit flavours.

2. MOONDARRA CHARDONNAY (Australia) 2 16.95

Everyone loves the ripe fruit flavours of Australian wine, and this Chardonnay is a clear reason why. Delicious flavours of peaches and pineapple, with a creamy feel in the mouth, and a soft fruit finish.

3. PACIFIC HEIGHTS ZINFANDEL ROSÉ (California) 3A 16.95

Zinfandel Blush has proved itself very popular recently. This is a medium style.

4. MOONDARRA SHIRAZ (Australia) C 16.95

This is a great Shiraz from Australia, big and bold with ripe fruit flavours of blackberries and a hint of oak on the finish.

Smooth, succulent and plummy style with delicate hints of spice and crushed black pepper. Extremely popular and well priced.

6. NIEL JOUBERT SAUVIGNON BLANC (South Africa) 2 19.95

Sauvignon Blanc made in a fuller and richer style with a lingering tropical fruit aftertaste.

7. B&G RESERVE VIOGNIER (Languedoc, France) 3 20.95

This is a very expressive, well balanced wine with an essence of apricots and pears finishing with a round and fresh palate. Sourced from grapes grown in the Pays d'Oc region of Languedoc by the excellent Barton & Guestier Company.

8. BELLA MODELLA PINOT GRIGIO (Italy) 2 20.95

Light, vibrant and very tasty. Very drinkable with or without food and strikingly presented.

9. PASOS DE LA CAPULA VERDEJO (Spain) 2 22.95

This wine is made in the oldest winemaking region of Spain – the high central plateau of Old Castilla. 100% Verdejo this is a beautifully balanced wine with hints of green apples, almonds and spice. The wine's natural acidity provides a lovely freshness and clean finish.

10. CHABLIS RÉSERVE DU MONTAIGU, J. MOREAU ET FILS (France) 1 30.95

Flint and mineral flavours combine with the lemon fruit of the Chardonnay giving a long finish. Moreau Chablis is as consistent as ever and a regular prize winner.

11. PROSECCO DI MARIA, CASA VINICOLA BOTTER (Italy) 2 26.00

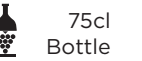
Fresh and crisp with lovely balancing citrusy fruit. This is a stylish Prosecco made by the incomparable Luca Botter. Looks and tastes fantastic - a genuine find!

12. MATEUS SPARKLING ROSÉ (Portugal) 2B 27.00

Refined, crisp rosé with floral nuances, pleasing aromas of apples, pears and raspberries and a delicate finish.

14. CASA SANTIAGO MERLOT (Chile) C 19.95

Family produced and estate bottled wine by Vina Requiringua in the Curico Valley. Generous ripe, red berry fruit flavours are combined with soft tannins and hints of cassis and mint. Beautifully balance wine with good length – tremendous value for money.

15. VISTAMAR SEPIA RESERVA MALBEC (Chile) C 20.95

Luscious lip smacking Malbec with lots of succulent tasty fruit. Aged 10-12 months in French and American oak results in a toffee and vanilla flavour and an elegant integrated finish.

16. ANTIGUO FUERTE TEMPRANILLO CRIANZA (Spain) C 20.95

A premium Crianza Tempranillo from the famous Valdepenas Region of Spain's mid south. Rich and complex flavours combined with smooth cherry and blueberry characteristics combined with the subtle use of oak result in a finish of clove and vanilla notes. Stylishly presented bottle using traditional "chicken wire".

17. EL COTO RIOJA CRIANZA (Spain) C 23.95

El Coto has in just thirty years become the No.1 Rioja in Spain. Their Rioja Crianza is ruby red, has excellent harmony of fruit, tannin and oak and is renowned for its velvety smooth feel in the mouth.

18. BAROLO STEFANO (Italy) D 38.00

Classically Barolo is Italy's greatest red with the Nebbiolo grape producing a dense but fragrant and dry red with lots of tannin and a clean finish. This has real elegance.

ROSÉ WINES

13. SARTORI PINOT GRIGIO BLUSH (Italy) 2A 19.95

Elegant, soft and fruity with summer fruit flavours and just a hint of sweetness.
